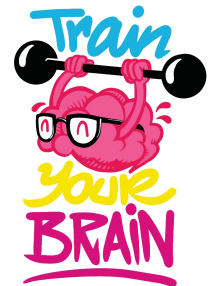

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The Project

The aim of this project, is to prioritize safety and remote learning is the most feasible solution to keep the school's community engaged in learning, away from the classroom.

Priority will be given to develop materials that enable the teachers to provide online classes that introduce students to innovative subjects and simultaneously focus on student's personal development in social distancing environment.

Furthermore: train the teachers to become more confident and independent in using the tools. The Programme will also support actions that develop or disseminate technological tools, as well as actions that apply the "learning outcomes" approaches in carrying out education, training and youth activities or assessing their quality and relevance.

The key objective of the project is to develop a complete and concrete toolkit for the teachers to help their students acquire new skills while enhancing their social skills in a day and age of a remote reality that sometimes weakens social interactions.
